Attractive purity and cut here. Try from 2022.</p> <p><b>Mars 2017 :</b> 92 - 93 This is really salty and minerally with fantastic depth. Full and intense. Such energy. Better than 2015</p>

Medium to deep garnet-purple colored, it features redcurrant jelly, raspberry tart and warm black plums with touches of potpourri, cinnamon and dusty soil. The palate is medium-bodied, vibrant and refreshing with pleasant chewiness and lifted finish. 1,000 cases produced. Drink 2019-2030.</p>
